

## SUBDIVISION OF T. 10 N., R. 30 E.

## Chains

Beginning at the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31, and 32, heretofore described, on the N. bdy. of the township.

S. 0°21' E., parallel to the E. bdy. of sec. 5 on true line bet. secs. 5 and 6.

Over slightly rolling land, through scattering undergrowth; desc. 35 ft. to the lake shore.

34.13 The mean high water mark, on the E. shore of Walker Lake which bears N. 68°30' W., and S. 68°25' E.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the meander cor. for fractional secs. 5 and 6, with brass cap mkd.

Beginning at the meander cor. of fractional sec. 32, heretofore described, on the S. bdy. of the township.

Thence, with the meanders of the east bank of Walker Lake in sec. 32.

Along the mean high water line, over a sandy beach.

N. 10°00' E., 40.00 chs.

N. 19°00' E., 24.00 chs. At 23.20 chs. an old fish house bears E. 2.00 chs.

N. 8°04' E., 18.11 chs. The meander cor. of fractional secs. 29 and 32.

Land, level.

Soil, sand.

Undergrowth, none.

Timber, none.

Thence, in sec. 29.

Along the mean high water line, over a sandy beach.

N. 2°30' E., 15.60 chs.

N. 21°45' E., 14.30 chs.
