

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE N. BDY. OF T. 11 N., R. 49 E.

Chains	<p>Dependent resurvey of the N. bdy. of T. 11 N., R. 49 E., as executed by Barker and Skinner, U. S. Deputy Surveyors, in 1875.</p>
	<p>The resurvey is a complete restoration of the original east 4 miles of bdy. in its true position according to the remaining evidence.</p>
	<p>Before restoring the cors., the line of the original survey was re-traced and search was made for evidence of the original cors. When properly identified or restored, the cor. positions were remonumented with iron posts.</p>
	<p>The rules of proportionate measurement were applied in order to ascertain the position of lost cors., after completing the necessary retracements to connect with the identified cor. positions; but not until exhausting every reasonable possibility of finding such lost cors.</p>
	<p>The true line notes only, are supplied here.</p>
	<p>From the cor. of Tps. 11 and 12 N., Rs. 49 and 50 E., which is an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record.</p>
	<p>S. 89° 40' W., along N. bdy. of sec. 1.</p>
	<p>Over rolling valley floor through medium dense undergrowth; asc. along a gentle Easterly slope.</p>
40.00	<p>Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, with a rock 4x4x5 ins., mkd. X, deposited at the base, for <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> sec. cor. S. bdy. of sec. 36 only, with brass cap mkd.</p>

	<p>Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, with original cor. stone deposited at the base, for <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> sec. cor., N. bdy. of sec. 1 only, with brass cap mkd.</p>
