

INDEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE SOUTH BDY. OF SEC. 32, T. 12 N., R. 49 E.

Chains

Land, rolling valley floor, 1st. 70 chs., then a steeper E. slope last 10 chs.
 Soil, sandy and rocky; 4th rate.
 Timber, scattered juniper and nut pine; undergrowth, button sage, white sage and some grass.
 Grazing, poor.

SURVEY OF SOUTH BOUNDARY OF SEC. 31, T. 12 N., R. 49 E.

From the cor. of secs. 31 and 32, hereinbefore described
 West, along S. bdy. of sec. 31.

Over mountainous land through medium dense undergrowth and dense timber; asc. 240 ft. over E. slope.

- 3.00 Eastern base of the Monitor Mountains.
- 19.50 Small wash, course S. 50° E., continue to asc. 350 ft. over a steep E. slope.
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 10 ins. in the ground, and in a mound of stone to top, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 31 only, with brass cap mkd.



A nut pine, 8 ins. in diam., bears N. 65° E., 54 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S31.

- 40.10 Top of spur, slopes S. 85° E., desc. 40 ft. over W. slope.
- 43.80 Top of rocky escarpment, bears N. and S., desc. 160 ft. over steep W. slope.
- 50.20 Ravine, course S. 20° W., asc. 150 ft. over steep E. slope.
- 57.40 Top of spur, slopes S. 80° E.
- 62.62 Intersect E. bdy. of Tp. 11 N., R. 48 E.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 6 ins. in the ground and in a mound of stone to top, for closing cor. of Tps. 11 and 12 N., R. 49 E., with brass cap mkd.

A nut pine, 12 ins. diam., bears N. 69 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E., 40 lks. dist.; mkd. T12NR49E CC S31 BT.

A nut pine, 12 ins. diam., bears S. 60 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E., 1.15 chs. dist.; mkd. T11NR49E CC S6 BT.

From the point of intersection, the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., E. bdy. of sec. 1,
