


SUBDIVISIONS OF T. 12 N., R. 49 E.

- Chains
 25.70 undergrowth; asc. 470 ft. over a very steep E. slope.
 Edge or rim rock, bears NW. and SE., continue to asc. 130 ft. over steep E. slope to $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
 39.00 Head of sidehill drain, course NE.
 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.



from which

A mahogany, 14 ins. diam., bears S, 28° E., 26 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S31 B T.


A nut pine, 5 ins. diam., bears N. 24° W., 30 lks. dist., mkd. B T only.

Asc. 70 ft. over NE. slope.

- 46.90 Ravine, course N. 80° E., continue to asc. 540 ft. over steep NE. slope to closing cor.

- 62.53 Intersect E. bdy. of T. 12 N., R. 48 E.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 29 ins. in the ground, for closing cor. of secs. 30 and 31, with brass cap mkd.



from which

A nut pine, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 35° E., 57 lks. dist., mkd. T12NR49E S30 CC BT.

A nut pine, 15 ins. diam., bears S. 57 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W., 2.72 chs. dist., mkd. T12NR48E S36 BT.

From point of intersection, the cor. of secs. 25 and 36, T. 12 N., R. 48 E., hereinbefore described, bears N. 15.22 chs. dist.

Land, very mountainous.
 Soil, rocky; 4th rate.
 Timber, juniper, nut pine and mahogany; undergrowth, button sage.
 Grazing, poor.

From the cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32.

Thence

N. 0° 03' W., bet. secs. 29 and 30.

Over mountainous land through dense timber and medium dense undergrowth; desc. 50 ft. along a NE. slope.

- 9.10 Slope changes; asc. SW. slope 30 ft.
