

SUBDIVISIONS OF T. 12 N., R. 49 E.

Chains


A nut pine, 3 ins. diam., bears N.  $55\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$  W., 29 lks. dist., mkd. BT only.

Continue to asc. 180 ft. over a steep E. slope.

50.80 Rock ledge, bears N. and S.; asc. 70 ft. over E. slope.

62.30 Intersect E. bdy. of T. 12 N., R. 48 E.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, for closing cor. of secs. 7 and 18, with brass cap mkd.



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from which

A mahogany, 4 ins. diam., bears S.  $45^{\circ}$  E., 9 lks. dist., mkd. BT only.

A nut pine, 16 ins. diam., bears N.  $15^{\circ}$  W., 59 lks. dist., mkd. T12NR48E S13 BT.

From point of intersection the cor. of secs. 12 and 13, T. 12 N., R. 48 E., hereinbefore described, bears N. 15.22 chs. dist.,

Land, rolling mountainous.

Soil, rocky; 4th rate.

Timber, juniper, nut pine and mahogany; undergrowth, button sage and bunch grass.

Grazing, good.

From the cor. of secs. 7, 8, 17 and 18.


Thence

N.  $0^{\circ} 03'$  W., bet. secs. 7 and 8.

Over rolling mountainous land through dense timber and medium dense undergrowth; asc. 60 ft. over a rolling SE. slope.

27.10 Slope changes to NE., desc. gradually.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 15 ins. in the ground, with a rock  $2\frac{1}{2} \times 4 \times 4$  ins., mkd. X, deposited at the base, and in a mound of stone to top, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.



from which,

A nut pine, 5 ins. diam., bears N.  $89^{\circ}$  W., 50 lks. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S7 BT.

No other accessory.

Desc. 30 ft. over NE. slope.

53.60 Ravine, course S.  $80^{\circ}$  E.; asc. 130 ft. over a S. slope to cor.
