Chains


A nut pine, 3 ins. diam., bears S. 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W., 28 lks. dist., mkd. BT only.

41.80 Small spur, slopes E., desc. 40 ft. over NE. slope.

46.70 Draw, drains N. 60° E., asc. 60 ft. over SE. slope.

57.80 Sidehill drain, course E., continue to asc. 110 ft. over a broken rocky SE. slope.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., over a X on solid rock and in a mound of stone to top, for cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30, with brass cap mkd.

A nut pine, 4 ins. diam., bears N. 57 $\frac{1}{4}$ ° E., 63 lks. dist., mkd. BT only.

A nut pine, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 55° E., 63 lks. dist., mkd. T13 $\frac{1}{2}$ NR51E S30 BT.

A nut pine, 6 ins. diam., bears S. 81 3/4° W., 72 lks. dist., mkd. T13 $\frac{1}{2}$ NR50E S25 BT.

A nut pine, 6 ins. diam., bears N. 69 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W., 24 lks. dist., mkd. T13 $\frac{1}{2}$ NR50E S24 BT.

Land, mountainous.  
Soil, mostly exposed surface rock, 4th rate.  
Timber, nut pine, mahogany and juniper; undergrowth, big sage.  
Grazing, very poor.

North, bet. secs. 19 and 24.


Over mountainous land through scattered undergrowth and dense timber, desc. 20 ft. over broken NE. slope.

10.40 Draw, drains S. 70° E., asc. 60 ft. over SE. slope.

23.00 Ridge, bears N. 25° E. and S. 10° W., desc. 190 ft. over broken NW. slope.

32.95 Intersect S. bdy. of Tp. 14 N., R. 50 E.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 15 ins. in the ground and in a mound of stone to top, for closing cor. of T. 13 $\frac{1}{2}$  N., Rs. 50 and 51 E., with brass cap mkd.

A nut pine, 9 ins. diam., bears N. 31° E., 60 lks. dist., mkd. T14NR50E S35 BT.
