

EAST BDY. OF T. 13½ N., R. 50 E.

Chains

A quaken aspen, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 2 3/4° E., 24 lks. dist., mkd. T13½NR51E S19 BT.

A quaken aspen, 7 ins. diam., bears S. 69½° W., 22 lks. dist., mkd. T13½NR50E S24 BT.

A quaken aspen, 7 ins. diam., bears N. 65½° W., 28 lks. dist., mkd. T14NR50E S35 BT.

From point of intersection the cor. of secs. 35 and 36, T. 14 N., R. 50 E., which is an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record, bears E. 1.71 chs. dist.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, mostly exposed rock, except last 15 chs., which is shallow loam and rocky, 4th rate.

Timber, mahogany, juniper, nut pine and quaken aspen for last 2 chs.; undergrowth, big sage.

Grazing, poor.

SOUTH BOUNDARY OF T. 13½ N., R. 50 E.

At the cor. of Tps. 13 and 13½ N., Rs. 49 and 50 E., which is an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of T. 13 N., R. 49 E., surveyed under this group, I turn from a previously established meridian and run

East, on a random-line, making proper offsets to the N. from the tangent to the parallel at 38.76 chs. and intervals of 40.00 chs. thereafter, setting temp. ¼ sec. and sec. cors. along the line bet. Tps. 13 and 13½ N., R. 50 E.; at 478.76 chs., the parallel intersects a N. and S. line 3 lks. S. of the cor. of Tps. 13 and 13½ N., Rs. 50 and 51 E.; the correction is 0.3 lk. per mile counting from point of beginning.

Thence

West, on true line, bet. secs. 1 and 36.

Over rolling mountainous land through medium dense undergrowth and timber, desc. 210 ft. over a rolling W. slope.

18.00 Leave dense timber and enter widely scattered juniper.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3-ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

Continue to desc. 60 ft. over rolling W. slope.

47.50 Wash, course S. 30° W., asc. 60 ft. over rolling easterly slope.

54.70 Main wash, course S. 20° W., continue to asc. gradually.
