

NORTH BDY. OF T. 13 $\frac{1}{2}$ N., R. 50 E.

Chains

- Over mountainous land through medium dense undergrowth and timber, asc. 310 ft. over a steep SW. slope.
- 11.90 Rocky spur, slopes S. 20° W., desc. 60 ft. along SE. slope.
- 12.40 Draw, drains S.
- 22.00 Ridge, bears N. 15° W. and S. 10° E., desc. 320 ft. over a steep SE. slope.
- 38.50 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 19 only, with brass cap mkd.
- $\frac{1}{4}$ S 19

- A nut pine, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 87 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W., 40 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S19 BT.
- No other accessory.
- Continue to desc. 140 ft. over a broken E. slope.
- 55.30 Drain, course SE., desc. 30 ft.
- 56.00 Drain, course S. 50° E. to junction, desc. 50 ft. over a rolling easterly slope.
- 70.00 Draw, drains SE., continue to desc. 60 ft.
- 78.50 Point for closing cor. of secs. 19 and 20, hereinafter determined.
- Thence, E. along N. bdy. of sec. 20.
- 78.80 Little Savory Creek, 6 lks. wide and 5 ins. deep, course SW., asc. 20 ft. over a W. slope.
- 81.87 The cor. of Tps. 14 N., Rs. 49 and 50 E., hereinbefore described.
- Land, mountainous.
Soil, rocky, 4th rate.
Timber, juniper, nut pine and mahogany; undergrowth, big sage and bunch grass.
Grazing, fair.

SUBDIVISIONS OF T. 13 $\frac{1}{2}$ N., R. 50 E.

- From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36 on the S. bdy. of the Tp.
- N. 0° 01' W., bet: secs. 35 and 36.
- Over rolling foothills through medium dense undergrowth and widely scattered timber, asc. 130 ft. over SE. slope.
- 15:00 Spur, slopes N. 30° E.; desc. 140 ft. over a broken NW. slope.
- 33.20 Main wash, course S. 30° E., maintains an intermittant trickle of water, leave timber.
- 34.20 Same wash, course S. 10° W.
- 37.30 Same wash, course S. 10° E.
- 39.00 Same wash, course S. 10° W.
