

SUBDIVISIONS OF T. 13 $\frac{1}{2}$ N., R. 50 E.

Chains

Soil, shallow and rocky, 4th rate.
Timber, juniper, nut pine and mahogany; undergrowth, big sage and bunch grass.
Grazing, fair.

N. 0° 01' W., bet. secs. 23 and 24.

Over rolling land through medium dense undergrowth and scattered timber, desc. 30 ft. over a gentle northerly slope.

32.66 Intersect S. bdy. of T. 14 N., R. 50 E.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground and in a mound of stone to top, for closing cor. of secs. 23 and 24, with brass cap mkd.

A juniper, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 63° E., 66 lks. dist., mkd. T13 $\frac{1}{2}$ NR50E CCS24 BT.

A nut pine, 6 ins. diam., bears S. 53 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W., 1.38 chs. dist., mkd. T13 $\frac{1}{2}$ NR50E CCS23 BT.

From the point of intersection the cor. of secs. 34 and 35, T. 14 N., R. 50 E., which is an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record, bears East, 1.65 chs. dist.

Land, rolling top of a spur.

Soil, shallow and rocky; 4th rate.

Timber, juniper, nut pine and mahogany; undergrowth, big sage.
Grazing, poor.

From the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35 on the S. bdy. of the Tp.

North, 0° 01' W., bet. secs. 34 and 35.

Over rolling and broken land, through medium dense undergrowth and scattered timber; asc. 50 ft. over a NE. slope.

8.70 Wash, course N. 60° E., asc. gradually.

23.10 Small wash, course S. 40° E., asc. 40 ft. over a rolling SW. slope 130 ft.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
