

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE WEST

BOUNDARY OF T. 32 N., R. 33 E.

Chains

Land, rolling.  
Soil, adobe mixed with sand, alkali and free from rocks.  
No timber; undergrowth, greasewood and sagebrush, grazing, poor.

South, on true line bet. secs. 31 and 36.

Over rolling land, through dense undergrowth, desc. 30 ft. along SE. slope.

5.30 Shallow wash, drains E.; asc. 20 ft.

11.20 Low sand spur, projects E.; desc. 10 ft.

13.40 Small wash, drains E.; asc. 10 ft.

17.00 Top of sand spur, bears NE. and SW.; desc. 30 ft.

24.00 Dry wash, drains E.; asc. 60 ft.

38.30 Top of sand spur, projects E.; desc. 10 ft.

40.05 Intersect evident remains of the original  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., which is a decayed stake, 16 ins. long,  $\frac{3}{4}$  ins. sq. with marks obliterated, lying on the ground alongside a limestone rock, 2x6x10 ins. with no marks discernable. No trace of mound, pits and trench are found.

At point for cor.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with a limestone, 2x6x10 ins., mkd. X, deposited at base, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

55.80 Wire fence, bears N. 42° W. and S. 42° E.

61.20 Edge of water of overflowed area now forming a reservoir, bears N. 55° W. and S. 55° E.

True point for the original SW. cor. of T. 32 N., R. 33 E., falls in reservoir.

Land, rolling sand dunes.  
Soil, adobe, mixed with sand and clay; 3rd rate.  
No timber; undergrowth, greasewood, shadscale and sagebrush.
