Chains	Soil, sandy and rocky, 4th rate. No timber; undergrowth, shadscale, greasewood and rabbit brush. Grazing, poor.

	Over broken mountainous land through medium dense undergrowth, desc. SW. slope.

25.60	Draw, drains S. 80° E., asc. NE. slope 80 ft.	
27.80	End of spur, slopes from S. 30° W., asc. 310 ft. over steep SE. slope.
