

COMPLETION OF THE SUBDIVISION OF T. 14 N., R. 28 E.

Chains

- 41.40 Draw, drains S. 80° E.
- 63.50 Divide, bears S. 15° W. and N. 15° E., desc. 40 ft. along SW. slope.
- 73.10 Small ridge, bears N. 70° E. and S. 60° W.
- 79.96 The cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12.

Land, broken and mountainous.
Soil, sandy 1st half and decomposed granite 2nd half, 3d to 4th rate.
No timber; undergrowth, shadscale and button sage.
Grazing, very poor.

S. 89° 58' W. on random line, bet. secs. 2 and 11.

- 40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

- 79.98 Intersect N. and S. line 9 lks. N. of cor. of secs. 2, 3, 10 and 11.

Thence


N. 89° 54' E. on true line, bet. secs. 2 and 11.

Over broken land through medium dense undergrowth, asc. 50 ft. over broken NE. slope.

- 3.00 Wash, course SW.

- 14.50 Low divide, bears N. 30° E. and S. 30° W., desc. E. slope 40 ft.

- 39.99 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., over X on solid rock and in a mound of stone to top, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.



Continue over broken land cut by numerous spurs and washes; and draining generally SW.

- 57.40 Wash, course S., asc. W. slope.

- 58.80 Spur, slopes SW.

- 62.60 Center of small basin, drains SW., asc. W. slope

- 67.00 Spur, slopes N., desc. NE. slope.

- 74.90 Slope changes to W., asc. 110 ft. to sec. cor.

- 79.98 The cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12.

Land, broken.
Soil, sandy and rocky, 4th rate.
No timber; undergrowth, shadscale and button sage.
Grazing, poor.

N. 0° 08' W. on random line, bet. secs. 1 and 2.

- 40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

- 79.63 Intersect N. bdy. of Tp. at cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, a 2 in. iron post, 3 ft. long, firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of T. 15 N., R. 28 E., book "S" executed under this group.
