SUBDIVISIONS OF T. 14 N., R. 29 E.

I commence the subdivisional survey at the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., which is an iron post, firmly set, mkd., and witnessed as described in the official record.

N. 0° 01' W., bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Asc. 30 ft. over broken SE. slopes, thru scattered undergrowth, up the bottom of a wash.

9.10 Leave wash, course S., from N. 5° E., continue to asc. 40 ft. over SE. slope.

15.80 Reenter same wash, course S. from N. 5° W., continue to asc. 50 ft. over rocky SW. slope.

20.10 Along a rocky westerly slope.

28.40 Wash, course S., continue to asc. a rocky S. slope 150 ft.

39.50 Spur, slopes S. 5° E., along an easterly slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 6 ins. in the ground, and in a mound of stone to top, for ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
