

SUBDIVISIONS OF T. 15 N., R. 29 E.

Chains

Over rolling hills through medium dense undergrowth, asc. S. slope 140 ft.

19.50 Wash, course E.

29.00 Top of knoll, desc. N. slope 70 ft. to $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.



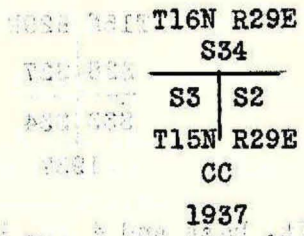
raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base and 2 ft. high, W. of cor.

Continue to asc. 110 ft. over SE. slope.

47.50 Spur, slopes S. 40° W., continue to asc. 100 ft. along SW. slope of ridge.

71.45 Intersect Third Standard Parallel North.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 10 ins. in the ground, and in a mound of stone to top, for closing cor. of secs. 2 and 3, with brass cap mkd.



From the point of intersection the standard $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., S. bdy. of sec. 34, T. 16 N., R. 29 E., bears E. 18.79 chs. dist.; a 1 in. iron post firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the resurvey of the Third Standard Parallel North, executed under this Group.

From this same point the standard sec. cor. of secs. 33 and 34, T. 16 N., R. 29 E., bears W. 21.21 chs. dist., a 2 in. iron post firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the resurvey of the Third Standard Parallel North, executed under this Group.

Land, rolling mountainous.
Soil, sandy and rocky, 4th rate.
No timber.
Undergrowth, shadscale, greasewood and rabbit brush.
Grazing, fair.

From the cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34, Tps. 14 and 15 N., R. 29 E., a 2 in. iron post firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the survey of T. 14 N., R. 29 E., executed under this Group.

N. 0° 02' W., bet. secs. 33 and 34.

Over broken mountainous land through scattered undergrowth.

8.40 Spur, slopes NE., desc. NW. slope 40 ft.

14.30 Ravine, course N. 70° E., asc. SE. slope 30 ft.

18.60 Spur, slopes E., desc. N. slope

20.40 Ravine, course S. 20° E., asc. S. slope 40 ft.
