

ESTABLISHMENT OF $\frac{1}{4}$ SECTION CORNERS ON NORTH BOUNDARY OF T. 15 N., R. 29 E.

Chains

At a point midway bet. the closing cors. of secs. 4 and 5, and 5 and 6, and west 19.00 chs. dist. from the standard sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 32, T. 16 N., R. 29 E.; a 2 in. iron post firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the resurvey of the Third Standard Parallel North, executed under this Group.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 5, with brass cap mkd.

raise a mound
of stone, 2 ft. base and $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, S. of cor.

At a point West 40.00 chs. dist., from the closing cor. of secs. 5 and 6, and west 19.11 chs. dist. from the standard cor. of T.16N., Rs. 28 and 29 E.; a 3 in. iron post firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the resurvey of the Third Std. Parallel North, executed under this Group.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 10 ins. in the ground, with charcoal at the base, and in a mound of stone to top, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 6, with brass cap mkd.

General Description.

This township consists of broken hilly and mountainous lands with little or no tillable areas. There is no water within the township. The soil varies from a coarse shallow rocky clay on the mountainous slopes to a fine wind-blown sand in the narrow valleys.

There is no timber; the only vegetation consists of desert type undergrowth with shadscale and rabbit brush predominating.

No indications of mineral were noted. The entire area is adaptable only to limited grazing purposes in the early spring or late fall and winter seasons.

The main Schurz-Fallon road - an improved and graded highway - extends in a general north and south direction thru the west central portion of the township. Several branch roads - none of which are improved other than occasional grading - make all areas in the township accessible except the extreme northeast and southeast corners.

Schurz, Nevada is the nearest postoffice, supply point and railroad station and is approximately 15 miles south of the southwest corner. Fallon, Nevada is about 20 miles north of the north bdy.
