45.00	Low saddle in spur sloping SE. from SW., desc. 50 ft. over N. slope.
50.00	Draw, drains N. 70° E. to junction.
51.70	Draw, drains E., asc. 140 ft. over S. slope.
59.00	Spur, slopes E. from rocky knoll 1 ch. west. Desc. 80 ft. over NE. slope.
63.00	Draw, drains S. 70° E., asc. 80 ft. over S. slope.
68.40	E. edge of rocky knoll; desc. gradual N. slope.
75.70	Draw, drains S. 70° E., continue over rolling land.
79.00	Small draw, drains S. 60° E., asc. broken SE. slope.
