52.60 Spur, slopes N. 30° E.

63.10 Rocky draw, drains N. 10° W.

73.50 Spur, slopes N. 30° W., desc. 140 ft. over abrupt, rocky W. slope.

77.30 Rocky ravine, drains NW.

80.00 In rocky ravine draining N.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 4 ins. in the ground over a cross X, cut at exact cor. point on solid granite ledge, and in a large mound of stone, 6 ft. base, for cor. of lots 7 and 8 in Sec. 7 and lots 1 and 2 in Sec. 18, with brass cap mkd.

83.70 Crest of sharp rocky spur, slopes N. 10° W. 3 chs. thence NW., desc. steep, rocky NW. slope, 390 ft. to W. bdy.

92.10 Rocky draw, drains NW.

94.40 Spur, slopes NW.

100.86 Intersect W. bdy. of Tp.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground to underlying rock, with a basalt rock, 6x4x4 ins., mkd. X, deposited at the base, and in a supporting mound of stone to top of post, for closing cor. of secs. 7 and 18, with brass cap mkd.

As this cor. will hereafter refer only to R. 29 E., I alter the brass cap markings to read as follows:
