Chains

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, for closing cor. of secs. 6 and 7, with brass cap mkd.

Deposit a granite rock, 5x4x3 ins., mkd. X, at base of post.

From point of intersection the old cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, T. 11 N., Rs. 29 and 30 E., bears N. 4.11 chs. dist., an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record. As this cor. will hereafter refer only to R. 29 E., I alter the brass cap markings to read as follows:

Land, mountainous.
Soil, rocky loam, 3rd rate.
Undergrowth, shadscale, greasewood.
No timber.
Grazing, fair to poor.

From the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7, and 8,

N. 0° 03' W., on true line bet. secs. 5 and 6.

Over mountainous land thru scattering low undergrowth.

3.00 Small draw, drains NE.

7.50 Draw, drains N. 60° E.

9.50 Spur, slopes N. 70° E. for 3 chs.

16.50 Spur, slopes NE., desc. 110 ft. over NW. slope.

20.00 Draw, drains N. 40° E., continue over broken N. slope.

Intersect N. bdy. of Tp. at a point from which the cor. of secs. 33 and 34, T. 12 N., R. 30 E., an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record, bears East 16.68 chs. distant.

At point of intersection,
