77.49	Intersect W. bdy. of Tp., 7 lks. N. of cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25, and 30, which is an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of T. 14 N., R. 29 E.

	Over rolling land through medium dense undergrowth, along an easterly slope.
22.70	Drain, course S. 70° E., asc. SE. slope.
27.00	Road in a wash, course S. 45° E., from N. $44\frac{1}{4}$ ° W., asc. 30 ft. over SW. slope.
32.00	Main divide, bears N. 40° W. and SE., desc. 40 ft. over broken NE. and N. slopes to $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
33.20	Head of draw, drains N. 60° E.
36.30	Minor spur, slopes N. 60° E.
38.50	Drain, course N. 70° E. to junction.
