Chains	Over rolling land thru medium dense low undergrowth. Desc. along an E. slope.
26.68	Fence, 4 strand barbed wire, bears E. and W.
26.71	Intersect the N. bdy. of Tp., West, 16.84 chs. dist. from the cor. of Secs. 32 and 33, T. 12 N., R. 31 E., which is an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record, field notes of T. 12 N., R. 31 E., surveyed under this group. At point of intersection.
