Chains

Deposit an igneous rock, 3x4x5 ins., mkd. with a cross (X), at base of post.

Land, rolling.  
Soil, gravelly; 3rd rate.  
Undergrowth, shadscale and greasewood.  
Timber, none.  
Grazing, fair.

West, on true line, bet. secs. 3 and 34.

Over gently rolling land, through medium dense undergrowth; desc. 50 ft. to the sec. cor., along a gentle SW. slope.

33.00 Wash, drains SW.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
