Land, rough mountainous.

West, on true line bet. secs. 2 and 35.

Over rough mountainous land, through medium dense undergrowth; asc. 100 ft. over a steep NE. slope to the 12.40 ch. pt.

3.00 Draw, drains N. 15° E.

12.40 Summit of main divide ridge, bears N. 40° W. and S. 40° E.; desc. 300 ft. to the 35.90 ch. pt.; over steep W. slope.

21.20 Draw, drains N. 60° W.; desc. along N. slope.

35.90 Draw, drains S. 60° W.; asc. 45 ft. over an E. slope to the 42.30 ch. pt.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
