SURVEY OF THE WEST BOUNDARY OF T. 14 N., R. 31½ E.

From the cor. of Ts. 13 and 14 N., Rs. 31 and 31½ E., which is an iron post, 3 ins. diam., firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of T. 13 N., R. 31 E., surveyed under this group.

North, bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Over broken hilly land thru medium dense low undergrowth.

1.00 Broad shallow wash, course W., asc. 300 ft. over broken S. slope.

26.30 Spur ridge, bears E. and W. and spur slopes N., desc. along top of spur.

36.70 Spur slopes NE., desc. 190 ft. over precipitous N. slope to ¼ sec. cor.,

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 20 ins. in the ground, to underlying rock, with a limestone 3x5x5 ins. mkd. X, deposited at the base, and in a large mound of stone to top, for ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
