		GENERAL DESCRIPTION	
		This fractional township varies from rough broken hills in the southern portion to rolling hills in the north and gentle rolling lands in the central portion. Numerous dry channels drain the area in a general westerly direction. The soil on the hilly slopes is a coarse rocky loam; on the rolling lands, the soil varies from a fine wind-blown sandy to an alluvial fine-textured gravelly loam. The entire area is arid and the only vegetation is a medium dense growth of desert shrubs and bushes with scattering small areas of sand-grass. Considerable prospecting has been done in sections 35 and 36 but no definite indications of mineral bodies were observed. The main road from Fallon to the old mining
