## Chains

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REESTABLISHMENT OF SURVEYS EXECUTED BY T. K. STEWART,  
U. S. DEPUTY SURVEYOR, IN 1884, UNDER CONTRACT NO. 170.

Original alignment is maintained between recognized  
existent corners of the original survey; these  
corners now become angle points and are so marked;  
new standard corners are established at 40.00 chain  
intervals in departure counting from the standard  
cor. of Tps. 11 N., Rs. 32 and 33 E.

Beginning at the standard cor. of Tps. 11 N., Rs. 32 and  
33 E., hereinafter described.

West, along the S. bdy. sec. 36.

40.60 Fall 196 lks. S. of the original standard  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.,  
hereinafter described.

81.06 Fall 305 $\frac{1}{2}$  lks. S. of the original standard cor. of secs.  
35 and 36, hereinafter described.

The true course of the  $E\frac{1}{2}$  mile is, therefore, N.87°14'W.,  
and the distance is 40.65 chs.; the  $W\frac{1}{2}$  mile is, therefore,  
N.88°27'W., and the distance is 40.48 chs.

Beginning at the original standard cor. of secs. 35 and  
36.

West, along the S. bdy. sec. 35.

80.80 Fall 194 lks. S. of the original standard cor. of secs.  
34 and 35, hereinafter described.

The true course of the  $E\frac{1}{2}$  mile is, therefore, N.88°18'W.,  
and the distance is 40.40 chs.; the  $W\frac{1}{2}$  mile is, therefore,  
N.88°57'W., and the distance is 40.43 chs.

The true course of the  $E\frac{1}{2}$  mile is, therefore, N.89°17'W.,  
and the distance is 39.40 chs.; the  $W\frac{1}{2}$  mile is, therefore,  
S.89°52'W., and the distance is 39.83 chs.
