

## INDEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE WEST BOUNDARY OF TP. 11 N., R. 32 E.

## Chains

- North, along the E. bdy. of sec. 1, Tp. 11 N., R. 31 E.  
Over rolling mountains, thru scattering undergrowth. Desc. 15 ft. over gentle NE. slope.
- 6.40 Main wash drains N.60°E.; asc. 45 ft. along SE. slope.
- 18.64 Point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 6, Tp. 11 N., R. 32 E., as subsequently determined.
- 19.00 Spur projects S.80°E. 2 chs. to end; desc. along gradual E. slope.
- 20.90 Draw drains S.80°E.; asc. 50 ft. over SW. slope.
- 23.70 Ridge bears E. and W.; desc. 15 ft. over NE. slope.
- 25.20 Draw drains E. 8 chs., thence N.60°E.; asc. 55 ft. over SE. slope.
- 25.92 Point for the cor. of Tp. 11 N., R. 31 E. and Tp. 12 N., R. 31 $\frac{1}{2}$  E., as subsequently determined. (For description, see field notes, Tp. 12 N., R. 31 $\frac{1}{2}$  E., Book "E", this group.)
- Continue along the W. bdy. of sec. 6, Tp. 11 N., R. 32 E. Asc. 135 ft. along a SE. slope.
- 32.70 Rocky spur projects S.80°E.; desc. 230 ft. over NE. slope, to closing cor.
- 46.90 The closing cor. of Tps. 11 and 12 N., R. 32 E., which is an iron post, 3 ins. diam., firmly set and mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record, field notes of Tp. 12 N., R. 32 E., Book "G" of this group.
- Land, rolling mountains to valley floor.  
Soil, shallow, rocky; 4th rate.  
Undergrowth, greasewood, shadscale.  
Timber, none.  
Grazing, fair.

## SUBDIVISION OF TP. 11 N., R. 32 E.

- Commence the subdivisional survey at the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31, and 36, on the E. bdy. of the Tp., which is an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set and mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record.
- West, on a random sectional correction line bet. secs. 25 and 36.
- 40.00 Set a temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.
- 80.00 Set a temp. point for cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35, and 36.
- Thence
- S. 0°01'E., on a random line bet. secs. 35 and 36.
- 40.00 Set a temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.
