Chains

- 33.00 Small spur projects N. 2 chs. to end, $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.; desc. over slight W. slope.
- 34.10 Small draw drains N. 3 chs. to junction with draw at 28.20 ch. pt.; asc. 10 ft. over slight E. slope.
- 36.20 Low spur projects N. 5 chs. to end, $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.; desc. 25 ft. over short W. slope.
- 38.00 Draw drains N.; asc. 15 ft. to the 41.60 ch. pt.; asc. over short E. slope.
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

Deposit broken glass at base of post.

Continue over rolling hills.

- 41.60 Low spur projects N.; desc. 20 ft. over W. slope.
- 44.80 Junction of draws draining N.10°E. from S.30°E. and S.30°W.; asc. 20 ft. over E. slope.
- 49.60 Center of wide flat spur projecting N.; desc. 15 ft. over W. slope.
- 55.90 Center of draw 3 chs. wide, draining N.20°E.; asc. 130 ft. to the 77.80 ch. pt.; asc. over NE. slope.
- 67.80 Head of draw draining NE.; continue ascent over steep E. slope.
- 74.70 Top of spur projecting N. 2 chs., thence N.30°E. from main ridge S.; continue along N. slope.
- 77.80 Top of ridge bearing NW. and SE.; desc. 100 ft. to closing cor.; desc. along S. slope.
- 84.17 Intersect the W. bdy. of the Tp.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the closing cor. of secs. 30 and 31, Tp. 11 N. R. 32 E., with brass cap. mkd.
