40.00Set an iron post, 3 ft. long; 1 in. diam.; 30 ins. in the ground, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

Deposit charcoal at base of post.

Continue over gentle NE. slope.

57.60 Main road bears N.15°W. to Rawhide and Deadhorse Well, and S.15°E. to Luning.

68.34 Intersect N. bdy. of the Tp.
