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Chains

- 22.10 N. bank of wash, course S. 10° W.; asc. 120 ft. over a S. slope.
- 24.70 Hill bears N. about 2 chs. and S. about 20 chs.; continue over rolling hills.
- 37.90 Wash, course SW.; asc. slightly over a S. slope.
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 12 ins. in the ground to bedrock, with a quart of glass deposited at base, and in a mound of stone to top, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. with brass cap mkd.

- 42.70 Wash, shallow bottom 3 chs. wide, course S. 60° W.
- 45.50 Road, bears S. 60° W. to Deadhorse Well and N. 40° E. to Sunnyside; foot of descent, bears NE. and SW.; asc. 310 ft. over a S. slope.
- 56.80 Continue ascent over a S. slope.
- 66.80 Spur, slopes W.; continue ascent along an E. slope.
- 69.80 Top of ascent, bears E. and W.; desc. 100 ft. over a N. slope.
- 72.00 Shallow draw, drains E.
- 77.10 Spur, slopes NE.
- 78.80 Draw, drains N. 80° E.
- 80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 25 ins. in the ground to bedrock, for the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, with brass cap mkd.
