## General Description

This township is situated in Mineral County, Nevada. It may be reached, at a distance of about 30 miles, over an unimproved road, eastward, from Schurz, Nevada. Also, at a distance of about 30 miles, connection may be made over an unimproved road to Nevada State Highway No. Al at a

point about 20 miles southerly from Fallon, Nevada.

The land is rolling, except for the extreme NE.portion The general drainage is which is rough mountainous.

south and southeasterly.

The soil is a pulverized alkaline clay, shallow, and upon a rocky subsoil, from 3rd to 4th rate. It is of

poor fertility.

No timber is within the township and there is only a scattering stand of sagebrush, shadscale and greasewood along with sparse growths of alkaline grasses and annual weeds.

There is no flowing water; dependence is upon gathered rainfall and from Deadhorse Well, 10 miles southerly.
Mining of a mediocre intensity is the only occupation.

The population; dependent in number upon the success of the mining activities, is concentrated in the town of Rawhide, situated in portions of secs. 5, 8 and 9, in which three families resided at the time of survey.

Agriculture is impossible and grazing poor.
