Chains

Land, rolling foothills.
Soil, sandy to gravelly; 3rd rate.
Undergrowth, sagebrush.
Timber, none.
Grazing, fair.

West, on true line bet. secs. 19 and 30.

Over rolling hills, through scattering undergrowth.

- 1.60 Dry wash, drains SE. from N.; asc. 150 ft. over E. slope.
16.30 Top of spur, projects S. 30° E.; desc. 80 ft. over a SW. slope.
24.50 Dry wash, drains S. 30° E.; asc. 25 ft. over an E. slope.
26.80 Center of knoll, about 4 chs. long; desc. 40 ft. over a W. slope to 32.80 ch. pt.
29.80 Dry wash, drains SW.
32.80 Main road in bottom of main wash draining SE., bears SE. to Deadhorse Well and NW. to Schurz, Nevada.
40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., on solid rock and supported in a mound of stone 4 ft. base to top of post, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

- 44.50 Top of long hill, bears N. 30° W. and S. 30° E.; desc. 70 ft. over a SW. slope.
58.20 Dry wash, drains S. 30° E. from N. 60° W.; asc. 20 ft. over an E. slope.
79.32 Intersect the W. bdy. of the Tp.
At the point of intersection,
Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, for the closing cor. of secs. 19 and 30, T. 12 N., R. 32 E., with brass cap mkd.
