GENERAL DESCRIPTION

This township is, for the most part, an area of low relief, varying in elevation from approximately 4,100 ft. in the central portion of the E. boundary to a maximum of 4,700 ft. in the central portion of the west boundary. The central portion of the east half of the township is of the lowest relief, being a dry alkali lake bed free of undergrowth. The southern and northern portion of the east half portion of the township is made up of rolling flats covered with medium dense undergrowth. As the western part is approached, the relief gradually increases about 600 ft. in the central portion of the west boundary, where the highest point is found. This particular point is the main divide of the Gabbs Valley Range. The main divide runs parallel to the west boundary of the township, crossing the boundary at a point near the closing corner of sections 18 and 19. It then runs parallel to and east of the west boundary of section 18 for approximately one mile, recrossing the west boundary of the township at a point about 20 chs. south of the closing corner of sections 7 and 18, and continuing parallel to the west boundary. Rolling and broken hills make up the relief along the west boundary of the township, changing
