

## Survey of a Portion of the Subdivision of T. 12 S., R. 66 E.

Chains

Land, rolling.  
 Soil, shallow, gravelly clay loam.  
 Undergrowth, sagebrush, creosote, blackbrush, mountain rush and cacti.  
 No timber.

(Field work terminated at this point.)

## General Description

The area included in this survey varies from gently rolling nearly level to badly broken and eroded land. Drainage and general slope of the land is to the southwest.

The area is entirely undeveloped, except for an unimproved road which crosses section 32 in the northeast and southwest direction.

The soil over the area is generally shallow gravelly clay loam and totally unsuitable for cultivation without irrigation and there is no known water source available.

The only known present value of the area is for stock grazing and it affords only sparse palatable vegetation.
