S. 0° 06' W., on true line bet. secs. 2 and 3.

Descend 520 ft. to the 40.08 ch. point; along W. slope, through scattering undergrowth.

13.10 Draw, drains S. 25° E.; descend along E. slope.

25.00 Slope changes to S. and becomes more gradual.

31.60 Wash, drains SW.

37.00 Same wash, drains S. 75° E., about 2 chs. thence S.

40.08 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 14 ins. in the ground, and in a mound of stone to top, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

Undergrowth, black brush, creosote, sage brush, cacti.

No timber.

Thence from the cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33, and 34, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., which is an iron post, 2 ins. diam., mkd. and witnessed as described in Book "A" of Group 61 Nevada.

N. 0° 02' W., bet. secs. 33 and 34.

Over rolling foothills, through medium dense undergrowth; along slight SE. slope.

1.60 Old road, bears E. and W.

14.60 Wash, course SE.; asc. 30 ft. on a S. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
