80.04	<p>The cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7, and 8, Land, rolling. Soil, sandy to gravelly clay; 3rd rate. Undergrowth, black brush, sage brush, creosote and cacti. No timber.</p>
<p>RETRACEMENT OF A PORTION OF THE E. BDY. OF T. 10 S., R. 67 E., THE E. BDY. OF T. 9 S., R. 67 E., AND THE ESTABLISHMENT THEREON OF THE ONE-QUARTER SECTION CORNERS REFERRING TO T. 9 S., R. 68 E.</p>	
<p>Previous retracements having determined that a resurvey of this bdy. was not necessary, this retracement is run on true line throughout.</p>	
<p>I begin the retracement at the old cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7, and 12, T. 10 S., Rs. 67 and 68 E., which is an iron post, 3 ins. diam., mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record.</p>	
<p>I perpetuate this monument by building a mound of stone around post, to top, and alter the markings to refer to T. 10 S., R. 67 E. only.</p>	
<p>Thence N. 0° 05' W., on true line along the E. bdy. of sec. 1.</p>	
17.30	<p>The closing cor. of Tps. 9 and 10 S., R. 68 E., which is an iron post, 3 ins. diam., firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described in Book "A" of Group 61 Nevada.</p>
40.22	<p>The old $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, Tps. 9 S., Rs. 67 and 68 E., which is an iron post, 1 in. diam., mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record.</p>
<p>I perpetuate this monument by building a mound of stone around post to top, and alter the markings to refer to T. 10 S., R. 67 E. only.</p>	
<p>Thence, N. 1° 21' E., with continuous measurement.</p>
