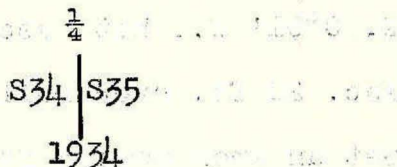

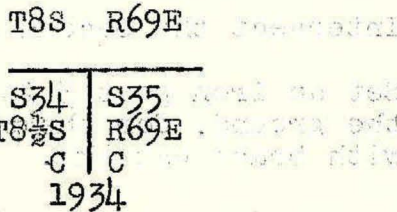


A rock 4x4x4 ins. mkd. with a cross (X) deposited at base of the post.

Asc. 45 ft. over rolling country.

60.81 Intersect the Second Standard Parallel South.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, for the closing cor. of secs. 34 and 35, with brass cap mkd.



A limestone 2x6x8 ins. mkd. with a cross (X) deposited at base of the post.

From point of intersection the standard cor. of secs. 34 and 35, T. 8 S., R. 69 E., which is an iron post 3 ins. diam., firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record, bears S. 89°56' E., 14.00 chs. dist.

From same point the standard $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 34, T. 8 S., R. 69 E., which is an iron post 1 in. diam., firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record, bears N. 89°56' W., 25.98 chs. dist.
