41.65	Side wash, drains S., asc. 90 ft. over E. slope.
47.60	Spur, slopes S., desc. 75 ft. over W. slope.
51.30	Gully, drains S., asc. 150 ft. over E. slope.
69.60	Ridge, bears N. and S., desc. 180 ft. over W. slope to cor.
78.46	The cor. of Ts. 10 and 11 S., Rs. 69 and 70 E.; monumented with an iron post, 3 ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record.

40.00	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36. Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 16 ins. in the ground to bedrock, with brass cap mkd.

Cor. is on broad ridge-spur, slopes S. 25° E., from N. Ascend 112 ft. on ridge-spur.
