raise a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 22 ins. high, around the post.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky.

Undergrowth, sagebrush, greasewood, joshua and cacti.

N. 89°53' W., bet. secs. 6 and 31.

Descend 30 ft. over gentle W. slope.

14.30 Wash, 50 lks. wide, drains NE. for 3 chs. thence N.; ascend 445 ft. over steep NE. slope.

40.00 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 31.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., over drill hole on rock outcrop, with brass cap mkd.

Ascend 100 ft. over NE. slope.

46.30 Ridge divide, bears N. 30° W. and S. 30° E.; descend 195 feet on NW. slope.

53.30 Wash, 30 lks. wide, drains N. 80° W.

64.30 Wash, 10 lks. wide, drains N., asc. 110 ft. on NE. slope.

70.00 Side ravine, drains N. 20° E.

75.90 Spur, slopes N. 30° E.

77.30 The cor. of Ts. 9 and 10 S., Rs. 69 and 70 E., which is monumented with an iron post, 3 ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky.

Undergrowth, sagebrush, greasewood, jushua and cacti.

SUBDIVISION OF T. 10 S., R. 70 E.

Beginning the subdivisional survey at the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, on the S. bdy. of the Tp.

N. 0°01' W., bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Over slightly rolling desert land. Ascend 30 ft. to $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

33.50 Small wash, 5 lks. wide, drains S. 50° W.
