SUBDIVISION OF T. 9 S., R. 71 E.

Chains

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground and in a mound of stone, to top, with brass cap mkd.

50.40 Wash, drains S. 20° E.

67.60 West rim of large valley bears N. 15° W. and S. 15° E. Descend 190 ft.

72.10 Base of 100 ft. high sheer cliff, faces E.

72.50 Valley channel, 50 lks. wide, drains S. 20° E.

76.60 Begin ascent over gentle SW. slope, Ascend 25 ft.

80.14 The cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33 and 34.

Land, rolling and broken.

Soil, coarse loam, gravel and rock.

Undergrowth, joshua, sagebrush, greasewood and cacti.

East, bet. secs. 27 and 34.

Over broken desert land. Ascend 166 ft. on SW. slope.

9.70 Ridge, bears NW. and SE., rim of large valley. Ascend 7 ft.

16.26 Intersect the Nevada-Utah State line.

Point for the closing cor. of secs. 27 and 34.

Set an iron post, 36 ins. long, 2 ins. diam., 8 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone to top, with brass cap mkd.

From this point the 292 Mi. cor. of the Nevada-Utah State line bears S. $0^{\circ} 14'$ W., 1.24 chs. dist.

At midpoint on E. bdy. of sec. 34, on the Nevada-Utah State line.

Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 34.

Set an iron post, 36 ins. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground and in a mound of stone to top, with brass cap mkd.

$$\begin{array}{r|l} \frac{1}{4} \\ S\ 34 & UTAH \\ 1953 \end{array}$$

From this point the 292nd Mi. cor. of the Nevada-Utah State line bears N. $1^{\circ} 56'$ E., 38.79 chs. dist.

Land, rolling.

Soil, sand, rock and gravel.

Undergrowth, joshua, sagebrush, greasewood and cacti.
