Chains

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long 2 ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, N. of cor.

Descend 10 ft.

41.70 Side wash, 5 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains SE. Ascend 15 ft.

44.60 Small spur, slopes S. Continue over general S. slope.

45.50 Wash, 20 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains S. 30° E.

50.70 Rut road, bears NE. and SW.

54.10 Small spur, slopes SW.

80.00 Point for the cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2½ ft. high, W. of cor.

Land, nearly level.

Soil, sandy loam.

Undergrowth, sagebrush and greasewood.

East, bet. secs. 3 and 34.

Over nearly level desert land.

.20 Wash, 25 lks. wide, course SW.

9.50 Top of small spur, slopes SW.

24.99 Intersect the Nevada-Utah state line.

Point for the closing cor. of Tps. 10 and 11 S., R. 71 E.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.

From this point the 299th Mi. Cor. of the Nevada-Utah state line bears S. 0° 38' E., 12 lks. dist., and is monumented with a 3 in. iron post, 12 ins. above ground, marked and witnessed as described in the official record.
