Land, nearly level.
Soil, sandy loam.
Undergrowth, sagebrush, and greasewood.

From the cor. of Tps. 9 and 10 S., Rs. 70 and 71 E., described in the field notes of the east bdy. of T. 10 S., R. 70 E., surveyed under this group.

East, bet. secs. 6 and 31.

Over rolling desert land.

Along S. side of large main wash, drains N. 80° E. Descend 7 ft.

6.50 Side wash, 30 lks. wide, drains NE.; asc. 110 ft. over broken NW. slope.

19.40 Spur, slopes N., desc. 90 ft. over NE. slope.

25.90 Ravine, 5 lks. wide, drains N., asc. 70 ft. over W. slope.

30.00 Spur, slopes N. 30° E., desc. 110 ft. over NE. slope.

40.00 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 31.

Set an iron post, 36 ins. long, 2 ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground to bedrock, and in a mound of stone to top, with brass cap mkd.

68.00 Wash, 5 lks. wide, drains NE., asc. 20 ft. over NW. slope.

80.00 Point for the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32.

Set an iron post, 36 ins. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground to bedrock, and in a mound of stone to top, with brass cap mkd.
