

## Survey of the North Bdy., T. 10 S., R. 71 E.

## Chains

Set an iron post, 36 ins. long, 2 ins. diam., 12 ins. in the ground to bedrock, and in a mound of stone to top, with brass cap mkd.

Land, nearly level.

Soil, course loam.

Undergrowth, joshua, sagebrush, greasewood and cacti.

East, bet. secs. 3 and 34.

Over nearly level desert land.

3.50 Wash, 10 lks. wide, drains S. 20° E.

13.70 Intersect the Nevada-Utah state line.

Point for the closing cor. of Tps. 9 and 10 S., R. 71 E.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground to bedrock, and in a mound of stone to top, with brass cap mkd.

From this point the 293 Mi. Cor. of the Nevada-Utah state line bears N. 2° 36' W., 42 lks. dist., and is monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., 18 ins. above ground, marked and witnessed as described in the official record.

Land, nearly level.

Soil, course loam.

Undergrowth, sagebrush, greasewood and cacti.

Subdivision of T. 10 S., R. 71 E.

From the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, on the S. bdy. of the Tp. N. 0° 01' E., bet. secs. 31 and 32.

Over nearly level desert land. Descend 13 ft.

2.40 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 1½ ft. deep, drains SE., asc. 42 ft. over gentle S. slope.

18.80 Top of slope. thence over rolling desert land.

22.20 Scraped road, bears NW. and SE.

40.00 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 32.
