A mahogany, 6 ins. diam., bears N. 46½° W., 80 lks. dist.,
mkd. T18N R52E S1 BT.

No suitable bearing tree available in sec. 7.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, shallow, rocky.

Timber, mahogany, pinon, and juniper; undergrowth, sagebrush.

North, bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Over mountainous land, through dense timber and undergrowth;
asc. 15 ft. over a S. slope.

- 4.40 Low spur, slopes SW.; desc. 32 ft. over a NW. slope.
- 13.60 Head of draw, drains SW.; asc. 41 ft. over a S. slope.
- 22.40 Low raise, slopes W.; desc. 20 ft. over a NW. slope.
- 30.40 Slope changes to W.; asc. slightly along same.
- 35.40 Low spur, projects SW.; desc. 16 ft. over a NW. slope.
- 40.00 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6.
- Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground,
with brass cap mkd.

Desc. 43 ft. over NW. slope.

- 52.10 Draw, drains NW.
- 54.50 Spur, slopes W.; desc. 25 ft. over a large basin, draining

- 65.08 Point for the closing cor. of Ts. 18 and 19 N., R. 53 E., described
in the field notes of the survey of the south boundary of T. 19 N.,
R. 53 E., executed concurrently under this same survey group.
- Continue line and measurement along the E. bdy. of sec. 1.
- 67.90 Draw, drains SW.; asc. 13 ft. over a S. slope.
