

## Survey of the South Boundary of T. 19 N., R. 53 E.

Chains

Asc. 140 ft. over a rocky NE, slope.

46.40 Spur, slopes N. 5° W.; desc. 245 ft. over a rocky SW. slope.

62.20 Mouth of ravine, course NW. which heads S. 25° E., 12.00 chs. dist.; asc. 10 ft. over a NE, slope.

68.30 Ravine, course N. 40° E.; asc. 150 ft. over a rocky SE. slope.

80.00 Point for the cor. of secs. 31 and 32.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 14 ins. in the ground to bedrock, with a limestone, 3x4x5 ins., mkd. (X), deposited at the base, and in a mound of stone, 2½ ft. base, 22 ins. high, with brass cap mkd.

Land, rough mountainous.

Soil, light, sandy, very rocky, mixed with gravel, decomposed quartzite, basalt, and shale, with numerous quartzite outcroppings. Timber, mahogany, juniper, and piñon; undergrowth, sagebrush, buckbrush, and a fine stand of native grasses and shrubs.

West, along the S. bdy. of sec. 31.

Over rough mountainous land, through dense timber and undergrowth; asc. 170 ft. over a rocky SE. slope.

9.50 Spur, slopes NE.; asc. 5 ft. along a N. slope.

11.80 Main ridge, bears N. and S. 20° W.; desc. 50 ft. over a broken NW. slope.

21.50 Head of ravine, course NW.; desc. 115 ft. along steep N. slope.

29.60 Ravine, course N., which heads S. 30° E., 2.00 chs. dist.; asc. 10 ft. over a rocky NE. slope.

35.00 Low flat spur, slope NW. and N., from S. 30° E.; desc. 40 ft. over a rocky SW. slope.

39.10 Ravine, course N. 60° W.; asc. slightly along a rocky NE. slope.

40.00 Point for the S. ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 31.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, N. of cor.

Thence over a rocky, broken rolling plateau.
