

Survey of the Subdivision of T. 19 N., R. 53 E.

Chains	
45.70	Center of paved U. S. Highway No. 50, bears N. 27° 10' W., to Austin, Nevada, and S. 27° 10' E. to Eureka, Nevada; desc. 65 ft. over a W. slope.
53.80	Wash, 15 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, course N. 25° W.; asc. 50 ft. over a NE. slope.
63.70	Wash, 10 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, course N. 30° E.; asc. 5 ft.
73.60	Wash, 15 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, course N. 15° E.; asc. 22 ft.
79.94	The cor. of secs. 2, 3, 10 and 11.  Land, rolling mountainous. Soil, light sandy clay, mixed with limestone and coarse gravel. Timber, juniper and a few pinon; undergrowth, sagebrush, rabbit brush, rye grass, and bunch grass.
	N. 0° 01' W., bet. secs. 2 and 3.  Over rolling mountainous land, through scattering timber and dense undergrowth; desc. 50 ft. along a W. slope.
16.00	Slope changes to NW.; desc. 30 ft. over same.
23.90	Low spur, slopes N. 20° E.; desc. 15 ft. over rolling land to wash.
25.00	Unimproved road, bears NW. and SE.
32.80	Dry wash, course NW.
33.84	Intersect the S. bdy. of sec. 34, T. 20 N., R. 53 E., at point for closing cor. of secs. 2 and 3.  Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.  <div>T20N R53E S34 ----- S3 S2 T19N R53E C C 1935</div> Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, S. of cor.  From this closing cor., the cor. of secs. 34 and 35, T. 20 N., R. 53 E., which is monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., 9 ins. above the ground, firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record, bears East, 0.65 chs. dist.  Land, rolling mountainous. Soil, light, sandy clay, mixed with coarse gravel. Timber, scrub juniper and pinon; undergrowth, sagebrush, rabbit brush, and a good growth of native grasses.
	At the point for the N. ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 2, at midpoint bet. the NE. and NW. cors. of sec. 2.  Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
