Chains

A juniper, $4\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., bears S. $13\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 17 lks. dist.,
mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S10 BT.

Desc. rolling W. slope.

Leave timber, bears N. and S. and continue through medium dense
low undergrowth.

Unimproved road, bears N. 10° W. and S.

Shallow drain, course NW.

The cor. of secs. 3, 4, 9 and 10.

Land, rolling and broken.

Soil, shallow gravelly to coarse rocky loam.

Timber, juniper and pinon; undergrowth, shadscale, sagebrush, and
buckbrush.

N. $0^{\circ} 02'$ W., bet. secs. 3 and 4.

Over rolling land, through medium dense low undergrowth.

Intersect the south boundary of sec. 33, T. 20 N., R. 53 E., at
point for closing cor. of secs. 3 and 4.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground
to solid rock, over a cross (X), and in a mound of stone, 3 ft.
base, 16 ins. high, with brass cap mkd.

Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, S. of cor.

From this corner, the cor. of secs. 33 and 34, T. 20 N., R. 53 E.,
which is monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set,
mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record, bears
East, 20.85 chs. dist.

Land, rolling.

Soil, shallow, gravelly clay loam.

Timber, juniper; undergrowth, sagebrush, shadscale, and buckbrush.

At the point for the N. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 3, at midpoint bet.
the NE. and NW. cors. of sec. 3.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground,
with a basalt rock, $4 \times 3 \times 1\frac{1}{2}$ ins., mkd. X, deposited at the base,
with brass cap mkd.
