Chains

A pinon pine, 9 ins. diam., bears S. 20 3/4° W., 25 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S11 BT.

45.80 Gulch, course S. 35° W.; asc. 40 ft.

51.80 Top of spur, slopes SW.; desc. 125 ft.

67.80 Ravine, course S. for 5.00 chs.; thence S. 30° W.; asc. 80 ft. over SE. slope.

78.00 Top of spur, slopes S.; desc. 25 ft.

79.82 The cor. of secs. 2, 3, 10 and 11.


Land, mountainous.
Soil, light sandy clay loam and rocky; 4th rate.
Timber, pinon pine and juniper; undergrowth, sagebrush, and buckbrush.
Grazing, good.

N. 0° 01' W., bet. secs. 2 and 3.

Desc. 40 ft. over mountainous land, through dense timber and undergrowth.

5.50 Ravine, course S. 55° W.; asc. 700 ft. over a rocky general SW. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 18 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone to top, for 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

A pinon pine, 6 ins. diam., bears S. 40 1/2° E., 24 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S2 BT.

A pinon pine, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 16 1/2° W., 48 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S3 BT.


This cor. is situated at the base of a nearly vertical cliff; asc. abruptly 100 ft.

40.60 Top of cliff, bears N. 30° W. and SE.; also forming a spur, projecting SE.; desc. 125 ft. along a very rocky broken E. slope.

60.70 Head of ravine, course SE.; asc. 200 ft. over general SE. slope.

79.59 Intersect the N. bdy. of Tp.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 18 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone to top, for closing cor. of secs. 2 and 3, with brass cap mkd.

A pinon pine, 14 ins. diam., bears S. 29° E., 136 lks. dist., mkd. T11N R59E S2 CC BT.
