A forked juniper,  $\frac{1}{4}$  ins. diam., bears S. 80° W., 33 lks. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S19 BT.

50.10 Top of spur, 30 ft. above  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., slopes SE.; desc. 10 ft.

A dim road, bears N. 50° W. and S. 50° E.

56.30 Ravine, course S. 65° E.; asc. 240 ft. over rocky E. slope.

70.40 Top of rocky spur, projects S. 10° E.; desc. 125 ft. over rocky W. slope.

77.79 Intersect the W. bdy. of Tp.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 10 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone to top, for closing cor. of secs. 18 and 19, with brass cap mkd.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, sandy, gravelly and rocky; 3rd rate.

Timber, scattering scrub juniper and pinon pine; undergrowth, sagebrush, shadscale and bitterbrush.

Grazing, fair.

At midpoint on the W. bdy. of sec. 19.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 19, with brass cap mkd.
