Chains

A pinon pine, 14 ins. diam., bears S. 34° E., 19 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S6 BT.

The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 1, T. 11 N., R. 58 E., bears North, 4.41 chs. dist.

From the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7 and 8.

N. $0^{\circ} 03'$ W., bet. secs. 5 and 6.

Over mountainous land, through dense timber and undergrowth, desc. 100 ft. over a general NE. slope.

14.30 Gulch, course S. 70° E.; asc. 10 ft.

30.30 Top of low spur, slopes S. 60° E.; desc. 10 ft.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

A juniper, 5 ins. diam., bears N. 55° W., 125 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S6 BT.

44.80 Ravine, 15 ft. below $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., course SE.; asc. 15 ft.

53.90 Gulch, course S. 30° E.; asc. 50 ft.

56.00 Dim road, bears NW. and SE.; asc. 40 ft.

68.50 Top of low spur, slopes SE.; desc. 15 ft.

79.15 Intersect the N. bdy. of Tp.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for closing cor. of secs. 5 and 6, with brass cap mkd.

A pinon pine, 9 ins. diam., bears S. 69° W., 35 lks. dist., mkd. T11N R59E S6 CC BT.

The cor. of secs. 31 and 32, T. 12 N., R. 59 E., bears East, 4.88 chs. dist.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, sandy gravelly and rocky; 4th rate.

Timber, pinon pine and juniper; undergrowth, sagebrush, and buckbrush.

Grazing, good.
