


EAST BOUNDARY OF T. 31 N., R. 69 E.

Chains

Over gently rolling land, through dense undergrowth.


57.80 Wash, course E.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for cor. of lots 4 and 5 of sec. 6 and lots 1 and 8 of sec. 1, with brass cap marked



raise a mound
of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of cor.

90.76 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for the cor. of Tps. 31 and 32 N., Rgs. 69 and 70 E., with brass cap marked



raise a mound
of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, S. of cor.

Land, rolling.
Soil, rocky and gravelly, 4th. rate.
Timber, none; undergrowth, sagebrush and greasewood.

EAST BOUNDARY OF T. 31 N., R. 68 E.

From the standard cor. of Tp. 31 N., Rgs. 68 and 69 E., previously described.

North, along E. bdy. of sec. 36, T. 31 N., R. 68 E.

Ascend 15 ft. over broken SE. slope, through scattering timber and dense undergrowth.

7.50 Spur, slopes E.; descend 178 ft. over broken N. slope.

27.80 Wash, course NE., road in bottom of wash bears NE. and SW.; ascend 6 ft.

38.50 Road, bears NW. and SE.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 20 ins. in the ground, to bedrock, with a granite stone, 6x6x3 ins., marked with an X at base, and in a mound of stone to top, for ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 36 only, with brass cap marked
